XI Emerging Markets Workshop

The New Economic Landscape in the aftermath of the crisis

Banco de España, Madrid, 4-5 November 2013.

The Emerging Markets Workshop (EMW), organised –alternatively- by several Eurosystem Central Banks, has been running for more than a decade. Last year, it was held in Vienna under the auspices of the Central Bank of Austria. The EMW has proven to be a very useful initiative for central bank researchers to get acquainted and to exchange views on research related to emerging markets being conducted in other central banks within and outside the Eurosystem, and also to disseminate the results of their own work.

The XI<sup>th</sup> Emerging Market Workshop will take place on 4-5 November 2013 in Madrid, Spain, at the Banco de España headquarters.

This year, the EMW aims at taking a wider view on the "The New Economic Landscape in the aftermath of the crisis" and, in particular on how emerging market economies are faring in this new environment. Among others, the topics to cover are:

- (i) Growth in emerging economies: patterns, models and obstacles
- (ii) Changes in policies and their interaction with advanced economies
- (iii) Shifts in risk and regulation and the structural impact on capital flows
- (iv) The European crisis from an emerging market perspective
