The Banco de España initiates the selection process for a new Head of Curatorship

The Executive Commission of the Banco de España decided, on 15 April 2014, to initiate a selection process to fill the vacancy for the Head of the Curatorship Division. The aim is to recruit an acknowledged expert in the field of conservation and management of historic and artistic property.

The head office of the Banco de España is an iconic building, with full listed protection granted by the Ministry of Culture. The Banco de España has, in addition, 15 branch offices, some of which also have protected status. These offices, especially the main building located on Madrid's Cibeles Square, house a collection of art made up of paintings, sculpture, engravings and numerous decorative works. This important collection, part of the institution's historical heritage, is painstakingly cared for by staff of the Banco de España, under the direct supervision of its curator.

Applicants should have a university degree or equivalent qualifications and at least 10 years' work experience relating to the architecture of historic buildings and the management of artistic property. They should have had direct responsibility for the siting, conservation, acquisition and lending of artworks and have participated in projects for the renovation and maintenance of historic buildings.
