Javier Aríztegui announces his departure and Fernando Restoy is proposed as the new deputy governor of the Banco de España

The deputy governor of the Banco de España, Javier Aríztegui, has given notice to the Government that he shall be standing down from this position after having informed the Governing Council of the Banco de España and the Minister of Economic Affairs and Competitiveness.

Today, in accordance with the provisions of Art. 24.2 of Law 13/1994 of 1 June 1994 on the Autonomy of the Banco de España, the governor, Luis M. Linde, has proposed to the Minister of Economic Affairs and Competitiveness the nomination of Fernando Restoy as the new deputy governor of the Banco de España.
