Rafael Castejón appointed to the Governing Council of the Banco de España

The Council of Ministers has resolved, at its meeting of 4 October, to appoint Mr Rafael Castejón Montijano a member of the Governing Council of the Banco de España. Mr Castejón replaces Mr José María Marín Quemada, who resigned from his post after being appointed President of the new National Markets and Competition Commission (CNMC).

Mr Rafael Castejón Montijano (b. Córdoba, 1949) has a doctorate in Economics from the University of Barcelona and is Professor of Applied Economics at the UNED.

Since 1971 Mr Castejón has held various teaching posts in the Economics faculties of Málaga, Seville and the UNED, where he was, successively, secretary (1981-1983) and dean of the Faculty of Economics and Business Studies (first, from 1984 to 1991, and subsequently, from 1999 to 2007). Between 1992 and 1994 he was director of the European Centre for Business Management of the Madrid Chamber of Commerce. From 1997 to 1999 he was director of the Department of Applied Economics and Economic History of the UNED. He is currently director of the Department of Applied Economics of the UNED.

Mr Rafael Castejón will take up his duties at the next meeting of the Governing Council of the Banco de España.
