## Exchange of Banknotes issued by the Latvian Central Bank (Latvijas Banka)

Compliance with the Guideline of the European Central Bank ECB/2006/10, on the exchange of banknotes by countries adopting the euro (Article 52 of the Statute of the European System of Central Banks and of the European Central Bank), the Banco de España shall, from 1 January to 28 February 2014, exchange for euro banknotes and coins the Latvian lats (LATS) banknotes and coins included in the following list that are presented for exchange, at the branches and under the conditions indicated.
