Appointments in the Directorate General of Banking Supervision of the Banco de España

At its sitting today the Governing Council of the Banco de España has ratified the appointments of Mariano Herrera García-Canturri as Director General of Banking Supervision and of Pedro Comín Rodríguez as Associate Director General of Banking Supervision, resolved on Friday 14 February by the Banco de España Executive Commission.

Mariano Herrera, born on 7 February 1959 in Sao Paulo (Brazil), is a graduate in Law and in Economics and Business Studies from Universidad Pontificia de Comillas (ICADE). He joined the Credit and Savings Institutions Inspectorate of the Banco de España in 1986. From 1998 to 2004 he was Head of Division in Supervision Departments II and III of the Banco de España. From 2004 he was Executive Coordinator of Supervision Department III of the Banco de España and, from 2010 to 2011, of Supervision Department I. In 2011 he was appointed General Manager of the Fund for the Orderly Restructuring of the Banking Sector (FROB), re-joining the Banco de España in 2012 as Executive Coordinator of Supervision Department I. In October that year he was appointed Associate Director General of Banking Supervision, his most recent position.

Pedro Comín Rodríguez, born in Zaragoza on 19 May 1961, is a graduate in Law and in Economics and Business Studies from Universidad Pontificia de Comillas (ICADE). He joined the Banco de España in 1991 after six years in the private sector devoted to audit and control functions. Until 2008 he worked as an inspector of credit and savings institutions in the Directorate General of Banking Supervision. In 2008 he was appointed Head of Division and subsequently Executive Coordinator of Supervision Department I. In 2012 he became Executive Director of the FROB (Fund for the Orderly Restructuring of the Banking Sector), his most recent position.

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
