VII High-Level Policy Dialogue of the Eurosystem and Latin American Central Banks

Banco de España today hosted at its headquarters in Madrid the seventh edition of the High-Level Policy Dialogue of the Eurosystem and Latin American Central Banks, jointly chaired by Vítor Constâncio, Vice-President of the European Central Bank, and Luis M. Linde, Governor of the Banco de España.

Banco de España and the European Central bank have been organising this meeting jointly for more than a decade, both in Madrid (in 2002, 2006, 2010 and now 2015) and in various Latin American cities (Rio de Janeiro in 2004, Mexico City in 2009 and Santiago de Chile in 2012). Its main objective is to foster a policy dialogue between the Eurosystem and Latin American central banks on issues of mutual interest.

This year's High-Level Policy Dialogue, in which central bank governors from both areas have participated, has focused on the interactions between monetary policy, macroprudential policy and financial stability, both from a domestic perspective and at the international level.
