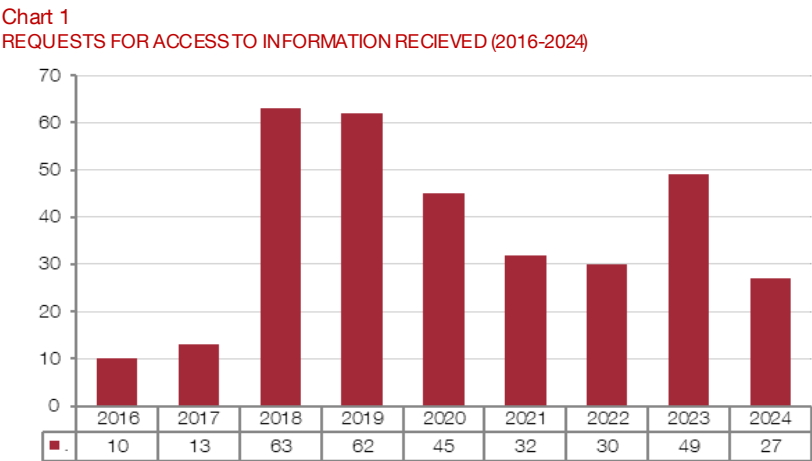

Methodological note: Some requests made covered various items of information, which may have led to more than one decision being taken by the Banco of España (for example, it may have granted access to some but not all of the information requested). In order to record each request just once:

- “Partial access granted” includes cases where access has been granted to at least some of the information requested.
- “Requests not admitted”, “Requests rejected” and “Requests transferred to other bodies” include requests that were not admitted, were rejected or were transferred to another body in their entirety.
