

Madrid, 30 and 31 October

Aim and content

The aim of the meeting is to facilitate the exchange of ideas between researchers of Latin American central banks on subjects of interest linked to macroeconomic, monetary, banking and financial sectors. The researchers' network is a forum for discussion of research projects and promotes direct contact between research departments to make it easier to identify joint projects. Furthermore, the network selects a topic of interest annually as the basis for research projects.

Professional profile of attendees

The meeting will focus on researchers from central banks which are members of CEMLA, although experts from other institutions, who will be able to present their own work, will be invited.

Organisation and format

The meeting is organised by CEMLA and by the collaborating central bank, in this case, the Banco de España. Participation will be decided on the basis of the research papers submitted by central banks, which are members of CEMLA. Subsequently, an ad hoc committee will select participants from the papers submitted.

The meeting will be hosted by the Banco de España. This will involve the presentation of the papers selected for the Researchers' Meeting, as well as the central bank projects conducted on the annual research topic chosen by the researchers' network, and a meeting to determine the network's organisational aspects for the following year.

Participation is by invitation only. Registrations will be processed by CEMLA.
