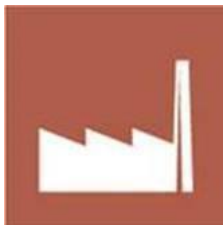
New dataset:



STRUCTURE OF NON-FINANCIAL CORPORATE GROUPS (GRP)

This dataset comprises a non-statistical sample of more than 13,000 groups. It contains data on the structure of non-financial corporate groups whose parent companies are domiciled in Spain, but whose subsidiaries are based anywhere in the world, in addition to information on their turnover and headcount.

Microdata on individual enterprises (CBI)

2020 update, adding a further 341,449 enterprises to the sample. An ancillary file with data on employment by gender and type of contract has been added



Microdata on debt securities issuance (BEV)

New monthly data for the second half of 2021. The time series available covers January 2010-December 2021



Microdata on Spanish non-bank fintech entities (FIN)

New data for 2020. The time series available covers 2018-2020
