The table shows information for the last five years, the first year of the serie (1983) and one intermediate year (1990). There is availability of the whole serie 1983 to 2012.

As a result of the entry into force of Commission Regulation (EC) No 1889/2002, the treatment of Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM) in the Spanish National Accounts (CNE) base 2008 has been modified. In the CNE base 1995, FISIM were recorded as the intermediate consumption of a nominal sector or industry (which did not produce either goods or services, so that its GVA was a negative amount equal to FISIM). However, in the CNE base 2008, following the entry into force of the above-mentioned regulation, FISIM are allocated to each of the sectors or industries that use these services and that record them as intermediate consumption and as final consumption. Recording the intermediate consumption of FISIM by non-financial corporations makes for a better measure of the contribution of the sector's GVA to GDP. Evidently, the GVA thus obtained is smaller than that obtained before the entry into force of the Regulation.

The columns «CBSO coverage» show the percentage covered by the Central Balance Sheet Office of Gross Value Added at basic prices, Average number of employees and Personnel costs, in relation to the amounts estimated by the National Accounts for each activity grouping. In any case, the comparative figures of this table are approximate, because there is no identical definition between the aggregates compared (see text of the publication).

The columns «CBSO coverage» show, for Gross Value Added at basic prices, the Average number of employees and Personnel costs (including sole proprietors), the percentage covered by the CBSO in relation to the estimated totals of the Regional Accounts for each Comunidad Autónoma (region). The aim is to evidence the limits of the use of the CBSO for regional studies. Each company is classified according to the region of the registered office. Regional Accounts takes into account the regions where the corporation has produced the output or paid the factors. On the contrary, column b.2 «CBSO coverage, according to work centre», is a good Personnel costs indicator of the regional coverage of the CBSO, without any bias of the kind described (see text of this publication).
