### **Banco de España to host international roundtable meeting “Water and financial stability: moving from risks to resilience”**

On 21 and 22 May, the Banco de España will host at its Madrid headquarters **Water and financial stability: moving from risks to resilience**, a high-level international meeting convened jointly by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), the Network of Central Banks and Supervisors for Greening the Financial System (NGFS) and CDP. The meeting forms part of the work of the OECD Roundtable on Financing Water, and will focus on analysing the macroeconomic and financial risks stemming from water scarcity, variability and quality.

The two-day conference, to be opened by the Deputy Governor of the Banco de España, will bring together senior representatives from central banks and financial authorities, leaders from international organisations, financial institutions, business and insurance, and academic researchers.

The agenda will address, among other topics, sectoral vulnerabilities, sovereign exposure, price stability implications, supervisory responses and the insurance protection gaps associated with water-related risks. The meeting seeks to collectively advance understanding of water as a systemic financial stability risk and to explore measures that can strengthen economic and financial system resilience.
