HIGH-QUALITY STATISTICS ...

The Banco de España prepares and disseminates a broad set of economic and financial statistics.

These statistics are compiled according to best international practice in official statistics. This ensures greater accuracy, within appropriate and previously notified periods, with information that is coherent and internationally comparable. All in close cooperation with other national statistics institutions.

... WITH IMPORTANT INFORMATION...

The Banco de España's statistics are designed to meet the information needs of Spanish society (economic policymakers, academics and economists, as well as the general public) and of the international institutions of which Spain is a member (especially the European Union and the European System of Central Banks)

... ON SPANISH ECONOMIC SECTORS ...

The Banco de España's role as a central bank (in its different facets) means that financial information is its main statistical resource. Nevertheless, over the years it has gradually taken on the task of preparing non-financial statistics, supplying information on all the institutional sectors of the Spanish economy.

... AVAILABLE TO ALL...

The Banco de España submits many of its statistics to international bodies (notably including the ECB, Eurostat and the IMF).

But it is also responsible for providing the information it produces to the general public – and is more than willing to do so – and this information is free of charge and accessible to any user.

... AND IN VARIOUS FORMATS

The Banco de España's website (www.bde.es/bde/en/) which has a specific area dedicated to statistics, is the main channel through which this information is made available to the general public.

The information is provided with different levels of detail and in various formats, tailored to different user profiles.

	BALANCE OF PAYMENTS AND INTERNATIONAL INVESTMENT POSITION	Information on the financial and non-financial transactions of the Spanish economy with the rest of the world, and its financial position with the rest of the world
FINANCIAL SECTOR	FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS	Information on the activity of Financial Institutions (balance sheets, loans, deposits), including the Banco de España
	FINANCIAL MARKETS	Statistics on securities issuance, securities trading (prices and volume) and securities holders, and on over the counter (OTC) foreign exchange and interest rate derivative markets
	PAYMENT SYSTEMS	Payments made in the Spanish economy. Includes payments between financial institutions and retail payments, including payments made with bank cards and other instruments
	CREDIT INSTITUTIONS' FINANCIAL AND PRUDENTIAL REPORTING	Aggregate and individual information on credit institutions' balance sheets and on their profitability, solvency and asset quality
	INTEREST RATES	Statistics on official interest rates, monetary policy rates and rates applied by Monetary Financial Institutions in their transactions with households and firms
	EXCHANGE RATES	Official and unofficial euro and US dollar exchange rates Includes competitiveness indices for the Spanish economy vis-à-vis various economic areas
	GENERAL GOVERNMENT	GOVERNMENT DEBT (EDP)
NON-FINANCIAL CORPORATIONS	CENTRAL BALANCE SHEET DATA OFFICE (CBSO)	Figures from the CBSO and Mercantile Registries on the activity of non-financial corporations
	FINANCIAL LITERACY SURVEY (FIRMS)	Financial literacy survey among small firms on financial knowledge, attitudes and behaviour, and holdings of financial assets
HOUSEHOLDS AND INDIVIDUALS	SURVEY OF HOUSEHOLD FINANCES (EFF)	Information on the financial position of households in Spain: income, assets, debts and expenditure of Spanish households
	FINANCIAL LITERACY SURVEY (INDIVIDUALS)	The survey aims to measure the knowledge and understanding of financial concepts among the adult population in Spain
CROSS-SECTOR STATISTICS	DATA LABORATORY (BELAB)	Microdata databases from various Banco de España sources, accessible to external researchers
	HISTORICAL STATISTICS	Compilation of statistics that are no longer published by the Banco de España and of estimates of historical data
	GENERAL STATISTICS	Non-financial statistics not prepared by the Banco de España (GDP, CPI, employment...)
