#### **Description**

## **Objective and Content**

The objective of this workshop is to train central bank professionals responsible for the design and production of banknotes.

Key topics include the technologies applied in banknote manufacturing, the different types of substrates used security features, an introduction to banknote design, quality management, as well as safety, health and ethical requirements in production. Current issues will also be addressed, such as sustainability in the cash cycle, applications of artificial intelligence, and the challenges of future banknote design.

#### **Professional Profile of Attendees**

The workshop is aimed at central bank professionals working in the fields of banknote development, technology or production. During the sessions, active participation of the participants, exchange of experiences, and networking with other professionals with similar responsibilities in other institutions are encouraged.

### **Organization and Format**

The workshop is held in person and conducted in Spanish with simultaneous translation into English. It lasts for four and a half days.

The workshop, organized by the Banco de España, combines theoretical and practical sessions, round tables and debates, with visits to facilities where banknotes, paper and security inks are produced.

It will feature expert speakers from the Directorate General Financial Conduct and Banknotes of the Banco de España, as well as specialists from other relevant institutions in the field of banknote production.
