

1st Workshop on Financial Intermediation – Banco de España

Madrid, 7 May 2026

CALL FOR PAPERS

Banco de España organizes a workshop on **7 May 2026 at its headquarters in Madrid**, aimed at fostering research and discussion of topics related to financial intermediation among academics, policymakers, and practitioners.

This one-day workshop will include six papers and their corresponding discussion by an expert in the field. Participants are advised to arrive on the morning of Thursday, 7 May, and depart on Friday, 8 May. The sessions will take place at the headquarters of Banco de España in Madrid from approximately 11:00 to 19:00, followed by a social dinner. The workshop will feature a **keynote speech by Prof. Rajkamal Iyer** of Imperial College Business School.

The Scientific Committee of the conference invites the submission of both empirical and theoretical papers addressing issues related to **financial intermediation**. Contributions focusing on financial stability and macroprudential instruments are particularly encouraged, although submissions on other related topics are also welcome.

Complete manuscripts should be sent in pdf format to financial-stability.conferences@bde.es. **The deadline for submissions is 2 February 2026.** Authors of the accepted papers will be notified by 16 February 2026.

Registration is free of charge. Travel and accommodation expenses of academic speakers will be reimbursed.
